Once you have submitted the completed form, you will be considered for all Northeast scholarships for which you are qualified. Southeast Community College Music & Theatre Scholarship:

Recipients are required to maintain full-time status, be in good academic standing during the time that they are awarded the scholarship and agree to participate fully. This includes attending rehearsals, participating in performances, learning and memorizing music and lines, and purchasing required dress clothing for performances for the entire season (October through June). The scholarship will be awarded in three quarterly installments of \$500 each for students committed to participating in the choir for an entire choral season (fall, winter, spring).
